Brent Geese, Wigeon, Pintail, Red-Breasted Merganser, Grebes, Golden Plover, Black-Tailed Godwit, Greenshank, Little Egret, Kingfisher, Rock Pipit, Dartford Warbler, Peregrine, Buzzard; Bearded Tit and Firecrest possible. Brent Geese, Pintail, Goldeneye, Eider; Black and Bar-Tailed Godwits, Avocet, Knot, Spotted Redshank, Whimbrel, Mediterranean and Glaucous Gulls, Great Northern Diver, Firecrest, Dartford Warbler, Peregrine, Little Owl.
