### Local Outing

#### **Saturday 16 Jun Rainham Marshes RSPB, Essex**

Medieval marshes next to the Thames acquired by the RSPB in 2000. Warblers including Reed, Sedge and Grasshopper plus Hobby, Redshank, Greenshank, Black-Tailed Godwit, Ruff, Lapwing, Bearded Tits and Avocet. Hides, Viewing Points, Visitor Centre, Café, WC.

Fenchurch Street to Purfleet. The 9.40 from Fenchurch St arrives Purfleet 10.08.

15-min walk to reserve. Meet at reserve reception/café at 10.30.

Directions on the RSPB website: 15-minute walk from the station following the brown pedestrian signs along the riverside path. Turn right out of the station and then join the path at the Royal Pub. Follow the Riverside path and then cross the Mardyke Bridge to the Visitor Centre.
