Dorset's bird life is among the best in the UK with just over 420 species recorded. Most hot spots are by the coast but there is good birding throughout the county. Neil is based in Dorset and is a freelance bird surveyor, natural history book seller, tour guide, writer and lecturer. He is also the editor of The Birdwatcher's Yearbook.

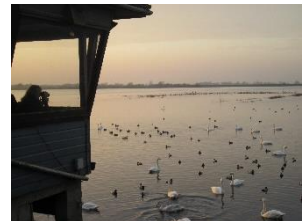
Hides, Visitor Centre, Café, WC. Entry fee for non-WWT members £6.53/£5.02 (65+).
