Species: Bittern, Smew, Goldeneye, Eider, Wigeon, Golden Plover, Spotted Redshank, Sanderling, Turnstone, Rock Pipit, Stonechat, Cetti's Warbler, Merlin, Hen Harrier, Barn Owl, Water Rail, Kingfisher. Facilities: Hides, 2 Cafés and Pub, WC.
